Students completing an additional internship semester (BOSC 4), are not required to pay any fees during that semester, but will have to pay for the mandatory Swiss insurances.

- 1) Subsidized fee for eligible Swiss students and foreign students residing in Switzerland. Please contact us for details regarding eligibility.
- 2) Mandatory Swiss insurances: accident, public liability, theft, computer equipment insurance covering theft and damage. BOSC 6 EHL Campus service fee includes: access to all sports facilities and sports activity training; Student Affairs Services (coaching, psychological support, health programs); Career Services (interview preparation, job fairs on campus); access to Digital Center and professional print-shop services; extracurricular student activities. Additional deposit (up to CHF 3 000) is required during semesters in Passugg for students requiring Visa/permit and Swiss health insurance.
- 3) Accommodation in Passugg starts at CHF 3 800 for a standard double room, more categories are available. Accommodation options are available at EHL, during the semester in Lausanne, but are limited. Monthly leases range between CHF 760 and CHF 1 120 depending on location (EHL campus or NeighborWood), features and number of students per room (single, double or shared apartment).
Heating, electricity, internet, hotel services are included in the price of the EHL on campus residences. For students staying in the NeighborWood apartments, heating, electricity, internet and supply of linens are included. Cleaning and laundry services are not included in the apartments.
Parking spaces are available on the Passugg and Lausanne campuses for a monthly fee. New accommodation and parking are under construction on the Lausanne campus.
- 4) Student cards are charged with a mandatory minimum amount to cover meals and beverages taken in the outlets on campus. The prepaid amount must be used before the end of the semester and is non-refundable. During semesters with accommodation contract in Passugg, full board is mandatory, with a choice between a 5 day or a 7 day Food & Beverage contract.

A down-payment of CHF 6 000 for international students and CHF 1 300 for Swiss students and eligible international students is required in order to guarantee their place. This amount is non-refundable, except in extreme circumstances.

Swiss students who wish to receive a scholarship must apply for the Tschumi Fund Scholarship.
