


FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

I COMPLETED ALL MY PRIOR STUDIES IN ENGLISH. IS IT STILL NECESSARY FOR ME TO TAKE THE IELTS/TOEFL EXAM?

The English proficiency examination requirement is determined by your nationality rather than your place of study. Applicants who are not citizens of native English-speaking countries are kindly requested to complete an English proficiency examination. It's important to be aware that you may submit your application without the exam; however, we kindly request that you provide your examination results at least one month prior to the program's commencement.

I HAVE NOT YET RECEIVED MY BACHELOR'S DIPLOMA OR TRANSCRIPT. IS IT STILL POSSIBLE FOR ME TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION? Yes, we kindly invite you to upload a Word document containing your diploma, along with a brief statement specifying your expected graduation date. Additionally, please upload all available transcripts as of your current academic progress; this will provide us with the necessary information to process your application.



WHAT CRITERIA DO YOU CONSIDER DURING THE INTERVIEW?

One of the key factors that sets you apart from other candidates is your overall motivation to join EHL and the specific program. It's vital to have a well-defined vision of your goals and how the chosen EHL program aligns with your aspirations. This is a highly suitable subject for your Motivation Letter, which should ideally range from half a page to a maximum of one page in length.



DOES THE LEVEL OF MY WORK EXPERIENCE INFLUENCE MY PROBABILITY OF ACCEPTANCE?

No, meeting the minimum requirement ensures that you have an equal opportunity for acceptance, just like any other applicant.



WHATTYPES OF WORK EXPERIENCE ARE CONSIDERED?

The minimum requisite work experience may be acquired through a variety of avenues, including internships, part-time employment, or full-time roles. It's important to note that as long as the work experience falls within the specified hospitality, tourism or service-related sectors, it satisfies the minimum criteria.



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WHICH DOCUMENTS ARE OF UTMOST IMPORTANCE TO INCLUDE OR ARRANGE ALONG WITH THE APPLICATION?

Listed below are the essential and required documents:

- · Bachelor's degree
- Transcript
- · English proficiency exam
- CV
- Motivation Letter (written by the candidate)
- · Passport picture
- Letter of reference/Letter of recommendation (can be provided by an academic figure, such as a former university teacher, or by a previous employer as a work reference).
